On July 31, 2006, Miss Margaret Fong assumed the post of Hong Kong Commissioner for Economic and Trade Affairs, USA, the most senior representative of Hong Kong in America. As Commissioner, she directs the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government's effort in promoting U.S.- Hong Kong economic and trade relationship, and constituency-building activities in the U.S.. Miss Fong also oversees the work of the three Hong Kong Economic and Trade Offices in Washington, New York, and San Francisco.

TOPIC: US/CA – Hong Kong Relations

Hong Kong continues to be California's eighth largest export market. California accounts for over 27 percent of all US exports to Hong Kong. California's exports to Hong Kong are driven by computers and electronic products, which account for 65 percent of all California exports to Hong Kong. Key exports to Hong Kong showing growth in 2006 include chemicals and crop production.
